- Acting at the local, state/provincial, and/or federal levels to address the root causes of injustice through advocacy and/or congregational or broad-based community organizing
- Participating in one of the Religious Action Center's current Urgency of Now Campaigns to act at the local, state/provincial, and/or federal levels
 - Protecting the rights of transgender students in our school district
 - Defending the rights of immigrants at risk of deportation
 - Reforming the criminal justice system to end mass incarceration
- Participating in a future issue campaign through the Religious Action Center
- Participating in a state-wide campaign with the Religious Action Center's state affiliate
- Fostering a culture of sacred and civil dialogue in our congregation where all opinions are heard

The Religious Action Center, in turn, commits to providing our congregation with:

- Actions to take, to address both the issues facing our most vulnerable populations as well as broader social justice concerns, at the local, state/provincial, and federal levels
- Campaigns to address the most vulnerable issues and communities, at the local, state/provincial, and federal levels
- Training to cultivate the tools/skills necessary to move our congregation into action

In keeping with eternal Jewish tradition, we, the undersigned clergy and lay leaders, commit to lead our congregation in advancing Jewish values in the public sphere.
