



Greeter Script

Please use this script as a guide when approaching congregants informally at Shabbat services, before/after Hebrew school, etc. Don't read this script outloud when talking to someone – use your own words.

Hello! My name is ____ and I am a member of our congregation's social justice committee. I want to share an upcoming opportunity for you to help prevent gun violence in California.

Have you heard about RAC-CA's gun violence prevention call-in week?

From April 29-May 3, our congregation will participate in the California Religious Action Center of Reform Judaism's call-in week to Governor Newsom, urging him to include \$39 million for Cal-VIP local gun violence prevention programs in his revised May budget. Cal-VIP programs have been shown to reduce gun violence by up to 40 percent.

We are joining together with almost 40 congregations across California who have together set a preliminary goal of making 800 calls to Governor Newsom. Our congregation has committed to making (insert number of) calls, but we need your help! Can you commit five minutes to call Governor Newsom sometime between April 29 and May 3? RAC-CA will provide a script and talking points, so you just need pick up the phone and make a quick call!

If you get out your phone now, you can register to make a call at www.rac.org/CAcallregister. Then you will get an email at the beginning of Call-In Week with a link to talking points, the Governor's phone number, and a place to record the results of your call.

We must act now because the budget process moves quickly, but just a few minutes of your time can make a real difference in preventing gun violence in California.
